I am excited about the next couple of months in our church. We will work together on a 50-day Spiritual Adventure starting on Sunday, January 12th. The Adventure is designed to make our church a better place. Our theme is "The Church You've Always Longed For: What You Can Do to Make It Happen." This spiritual growth event will run from 1/12 through 3/2. Each 50-Day Spiritual Adventure is built around eight weekly themes.

Each week will focus on eight specific ways to make our church--even a great one--a more inviting place to belong and worship. We will work at becoming the church you've always longed for by:

1/12- Working at being a caring family
1/19- Capturing the heart of the community
1/26- Welcoming all people
2/2- Empowering each individual
2/9- Modeling integrity

3/2- Anticipating a great future

In addition to hearing weekly sermons on these topics, everyone can join in the adventure with a journal at our church. Daily and weekly topics will help them learn how to listen with the ears of Jesus, share good things about the church with others, connect with individuals outside their circles, help each other become all God wants them to be, and practice personal integrity.
